The University of Minho

The University of Minho (UM) is a Public University established in 1973, and is considered to be one of Portugal's "new universities".

With over 19.500 students, 1.300 teachers and 800 non-teaching staff, the UM is one of the country's biggest universities, offering a wide range of first degree courses (*Licenciatura*) and postgraduate studies (Specialization Courses, Masters and Doctorate Degrees).

The UM is divided into three *campi* - Gualtar, in Braga, and Azurém and Couros, in Guimarães - both equipped with pedagogical complexes, Halls of Residence, canteens, libraries, laboratories, and sports complexes.
